00900. BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Special Attraction Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries - Show #1 Only

NR2.09100. Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and up to four (4) of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class.

NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog & Produce for Get.

NR2.09300. Brace Class - Two Dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class & entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

NR2.55250. Hottie Scottie Stud Dog Showcase - A Non-competitive event for stud dogs eligible to be used for breeding service. **There is a 2 step process to enroll. Step 1:** Enter the class using MBF/Infodog entry form or online entry system. **Step 2.** Go to <https://nescottiespecialties.com/hottiescottie/> and follow directions there. Exhibitors will prepare in advance a short introductory speech of three minutes or less about their dog that they will announce by PA system to the audience. Exhibitors also will bring 25 copies of an information sheet they must prepare and print for handout. The document must have pictures of the dog, date of birth, AKC registration number, AKC name, title(s), CHIC Number, a four-generation pedigree, list of noteworthy achievements, and contact information of the owner. The Dogs will be displayed singly and as a group in motion in addition to a "benched" segment where dogs will be stationed individually on tables set around the ring, so audience members, moving from table to table in groups of two or three, will be able to examine the dogs and ask questions and converse with exhibitors. MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

- **Dogs not entered will not be allowed on the official show grounds.**
- The Club and its members will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at these shows is in the care, custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- The Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
- All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the superintendent advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. The Club reserves the right to substitute any unavailable trophy offered with one of equal or greater value. Trophies offered and not awarded will become the property of the Club. None will be mailed.
- Any child on the grounds is the responsibility of the adult accompanying that child, and it is understood that adult will exercise control and restraint over that child at these shows.
- No extended Flex-Leads, Pinch Collars, Harnesses or any training devices are to be used on the grounds.
- No dogs allowed in any ring for practice.
- No grooming tables, crates or hospitality under any ring tents.
- Grooming tents are a courtesy for exhibitors grooming only. Please maintain aisles, stack crates and conserve space.
- Private exercise pens will not be allowed in and around ring tents.
- There are NO Camper Hookups.
- Do not leave dogs alone in unventilated or closed vehicles, including those left running with air-conditioning on. The Club reserves the right to remove from a vehicle dogs that appear to be in danger of overheating. Any damages are the responsibility of the vehicle owner.
- All persons attending these dog events hereby waive any claim for damages against the Ladies' Dog Club, Inc. or its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
- No smoking under the tents.
